PROM DRESS CODE:

Males: Tuxedo, socks and DRESS shoes. No jeans, tennis shoes, boots, caps, or sunglasses.

Females: Formal dresses- slits in dresses/skirts can be no higher than 5 inches above the knee. NO excessive cleavage or plunging necklines or excessively exposed backs. NO exposed midriffs. Spaghetti straps and strapless dresses are acceptable, but must fit the chest area securely and meet all other dress code criteria concerning slits, midriffs, fronts and backs.

- **Guest Dress Code:** all guests that do not attend LHS must adhere to the above dress code. It is the LHS student's responsibility to inform their guest of the dress code requirement.
- This form is due to Student Services no later than 72 hours prior to the dance, must be picked up in Student Services by the LHS student after approval and prior to the last day before the event, and must be brought with the student to the dance.
- Only one guest per LHS student allowed. Guest must have an ID.
- Any alterations, cross-outs, or white-outs will void this pass.
- Any incorrect or missing information will result in automatic denial of pass.
