

Statement of LHS Student and Dress Code

Statement of LHS Student: Students arriving without an ID card, without a guest pass, after lock-in time, or out of compliance with dress code for dance will not be admitted to the dance. Any student and/or guest in violation of the Student Code of Conduct and/or Homecoming Dress Code may be asked to leave and may face disciplinary action. All dance attendees will remain until the lock-in has ended.

HOMECOMING DRESS CODE:

Females: Slits in the front or back of the dress should be no higher than 5 inches above the knee; NO bare midriffs, NO see through (sheer) material on midriff and/or chest area. NO excessive side cut outs; NO excessive cleavage or plunging necklines; Dresses must be fingertip length. The bottom of the dress should not be higher than 5 inches above the knee; Bi-Level (Hi/Lo) dresses must be fingertip length; Minimum dress length must meet or exceed fingertip length; Strapless or spaghetti strap dresses are acceptable but must fit the chest area securely and meet all other dress code criteria.

Males: Suit /Sports Coat (optional), Dress Shirt and Pants, Tie, Socks, Dress Shoes. NO Jeans, NO shorts, NO Tennis shoes, NO boots, NO caps, NO sunglasses.

- **Guest Dress Code:** all guests that do not attend LHS must adhere to the above dress code. It is the LHS student's responsibility to inform their guest of the dress code requirement.
- This form is due to Student Services no later than 72 hours prior to the dance, must be picked up in Student Services by the LHS student after approval and prior to the last day before the event, and must be brought with the student to the dance.
- Only one guest per LHS student allowed. Guest must have an ID.
- Any alterations, cross-outs, or white-outs will void this pass.
- Any incorrect or missing information will result in automatic denial of pass.
